The Hutchinson Institute for Cancer Outcomes Research (HICOR®) is a scientific research institute based at Fred Hutchinson Cancer Center. HICOR's mission is to improve cancer prevention, detection and treatment in ways that will reduce the economic and human burden of cancer.

HICOR developed and released the Community Cancer Care in Washington State: Quality and Cost Report 2023 to improve quality and lower costs in cancer care. This supplement, Community Cancer Care in Washington State: Clinic Trends 2014-2019 is a companion document to that report.

These results have been reported in various versions of Community Cancer Care in Washington State reports and are designed to provide clinics with a comparable set of results to see year-over-year changes in the quality measures. Some individual clinic results are not available for every period due to variability in size of the clinic population or changes in clinic names or affiliations.
